But just before Jesus began his Great Rescue operation—where did he go?

To a university to get trained? To important leaders to get their help? To a spa to get some rest?

No. He went out into the desert.

That seems like a bit of an odd place to go. Why did he go there?

"Jesus needed to get away by himself and be somewhere quiet and lonely. He needed to be with his heavenly Father to get ready for his new life.

In the desert, Jesus thought about the Secret Rescue Plan he had made with God. Before the foundation of the world, they both knew what would have to happen. "Lent" is the time we remember this Secret Rescue Plan as well. And we make room for time with our Heavenly Father, too. As we read the stories of God's great Rescue we remember important things: we remember why we needed Jesus to come. That we can't rescue ourselves. How much he loves us.

"Lent" is the time just before Easter. It's a strange word. But it comes from an old English word meaning "Spring".

Think about spring for a minute. Just before Spring arrives, when it's still winter, what does it look like?

Not good.

The trees have no leaves. The flowers have all disappeared. The ground is hard as stone and the water is frozen. Most of the animals and birds have gone. It looks like everything is dead. But Spring is coming. And when it does—flowers, blossoms, rivers, leaves, life!

As we read this great Rescue Story together, God wants us to remember: however we are feeling today, wherever we are today, whatever is happening in our lives today—spring is coming. It may look like nothing is happening. It may even look like everything has died.


But...
