Sally recently performed her stories and poems in a twelve-city tour with Amy Grant and Ellie Holcomb. She has appeared at Carnegie Hall with The Gettys in their Christmas Show and with Andrew Peterson at The Ryman.

Sally was born in Kampala, Uganda, raised in East and West Africa and at a boarding school in the New Forest, England, studied at the Sorbonne in Paris, and now lives in NYC.
