
Friendship Hat


Here's a Friendship Hat for you to make, inspired by Hats Off to Mr. Pockles! by Sally Lloyd–Jones, illustrated by David Litchfield



Friendship Hat

- Step 1: Color or paint a paper plate (the lightweight ones work best)
- Step 2: Fold the plate in half and cut three equal sections as shown, stopping about halfway up the crinkled edge of the plate
- Step 3: Open the plate and cut your last two sections along the fold
- Step 4: Fold each section up so you have 8 peaks
- Step 5: Attach your friendship hearts (found on page 3) with glue or tape
- Step 6: Throw a hat party with your friends (furry ones count)
