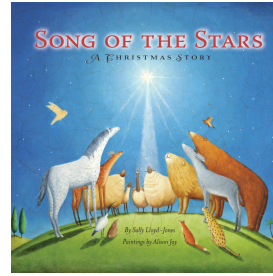


Star Ornaments

— Song of the Stars

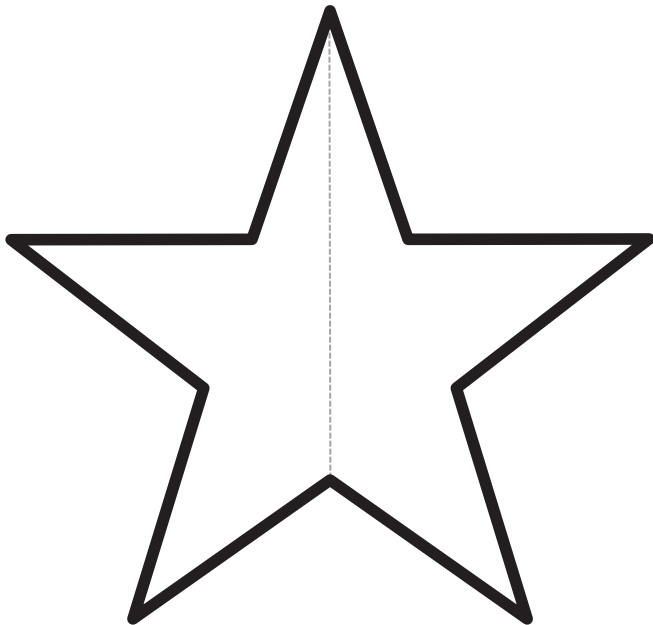
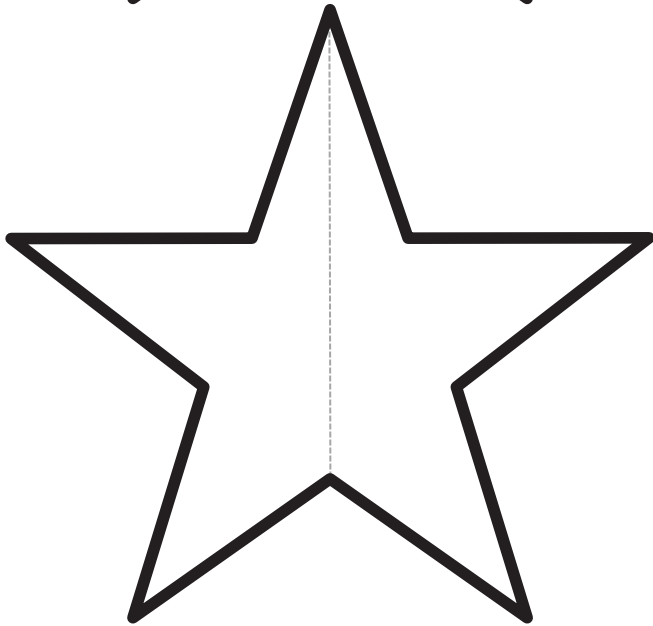
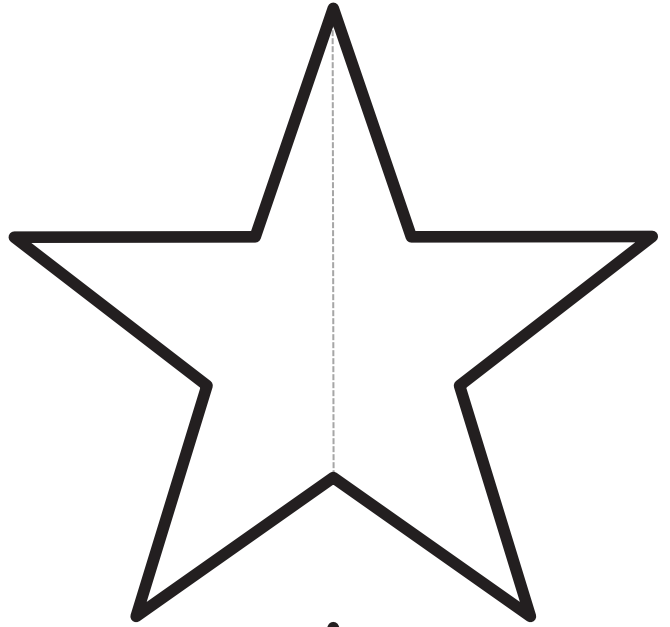
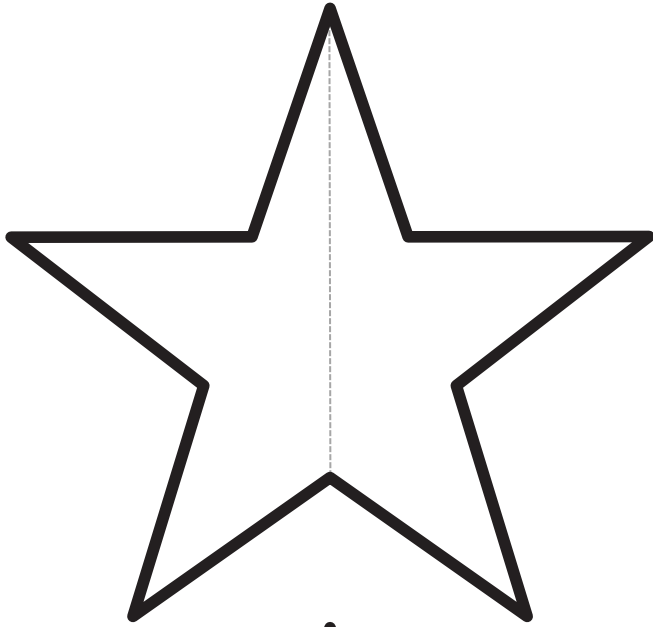


Instructions

1. Print the star template, preferably on card stock.
2. Color the stars and add glitter if you'd like. You need all five stars to make one ornament.
3. Have an adult cut out each star and fold in half (notice the dotted lines for folding). The colored sides should touch each other.
4. Line up two stars and glue the uncolored halves together. Repeat until your star is assembled. Before attaching the last star, glue a piece of twine to the center for hanging.
